- ☐ **Capital Letters**
Did I use capital letters where they belong?
- ☐ **Understand**
If I read this to someone else, would they understand it?
- ☐ **Punctuation**
Did I use punctuation where it belongs?
- ☐ **Spelling**
Did I spell all of my words correctly?



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
